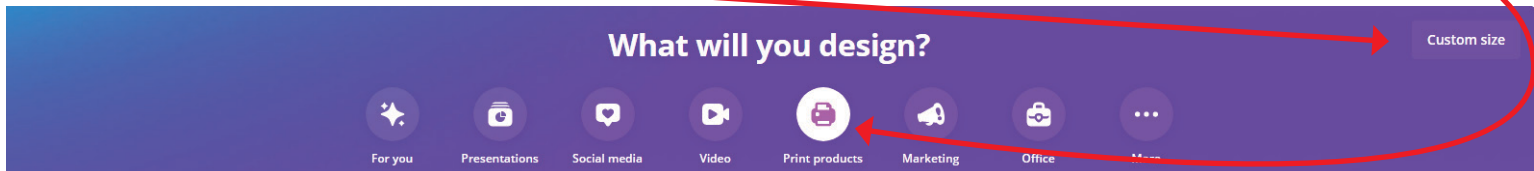


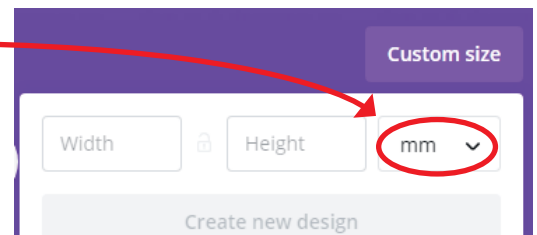
Canva – Creating Print Ready Files in 2 simple steps

STEP 1 - Page Set-up with 3mm Bleed

To create a print ready file from Canva it is important to make sure you are starting with the right type of file. The easiest way is to choose from one of the options in the “Print Products” Menu. Or by using the “Custom Size” button on the right to create a specific size document.



If using “Custom size”, you must ensure that “mm” is chosen and not “px” for the unit of measurement.



Bleed is required to ensure your design is printed to the edge of the paper, or white lines will be evident on the edges of your printed job.

To include Bleed, you need to drag the bounding boxes of your background images and objects 3mm past the trim edge of the page as shown in the image to the left.

Australian Standard sizing for print includes: B/Card (90 x 55mm), DL (210 x 99mm), A5 (210 x 148mm), A4 (210 x 297mm), A3 (420 x 297mm), A2 (594 x 420mm), A1 (841 x 594mm) and A0 (1190 x 841mm).

STEP 2 - Export your design with crop marks and bleed

Once you are happy with your design and are ready to create a print file:

Click on the download button.

Select the “PDF Print” File type

Tick the box for “Crop marks and bleed”

Click the “Download” button
